You will gain an understanding of the roles, responsibilities and fundamental skills needed to succeed in a warehouse environment which may include, but are not limited to:

- Communication and chain of responsibility
- Manual handling and using materials handling equipment, such as hydraulic jacks and hand trucks, to move goods
- Inventory, stock control and applying quality systems
- Operating machines to lift, place and remove good and using specialized equipment.
- Contributing to workplace health and safety

Please note: Units within this qualification require students to to have access to a warehousing environment. Your METS Trainer will visit the workplace to assess learners on the job and/or via video conferencing throughout the qualification.
